Step 1 - Base To Emitter. Connect the red probe from your multimeter to the Base (B) of the transistor and the black probe to the Emitter (E). If the transistor is an NPN type, you should see a voltage drop of anything between 0.45 and 0.9 volts. If you see this, the transistor is good to move onto the next step.
